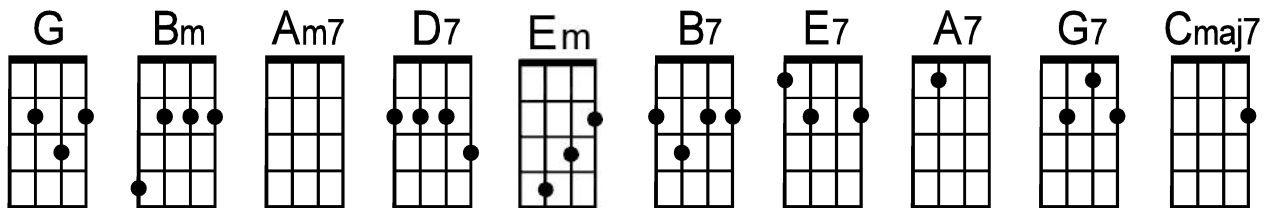


Have Yourself a Merry Little Christmas
