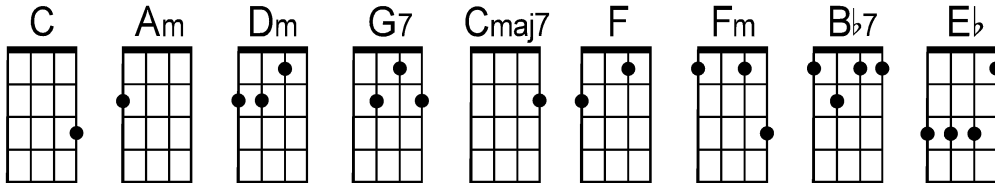


Blue Moon
