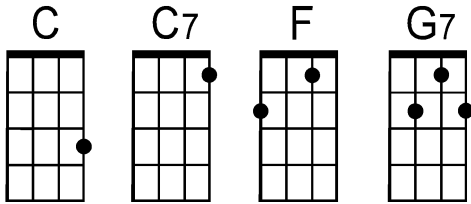


Blue Moon of Kentucky
