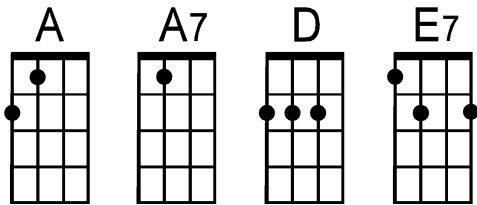


Blue Suede Shoes (Key of A)
