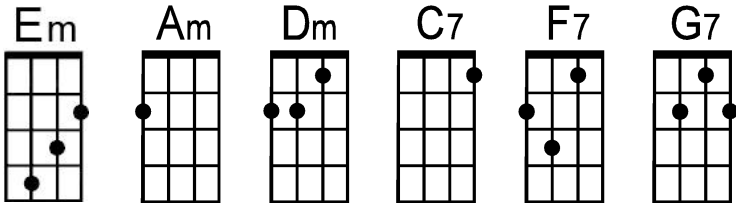


Can't Buy Me Love
