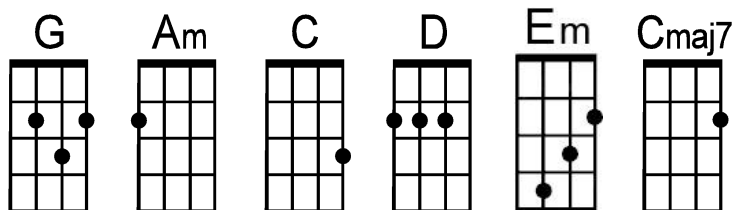


# Long Live the Ukulele (in G)
