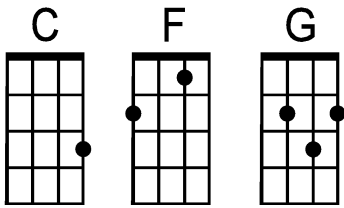


# Long Tall Texan
