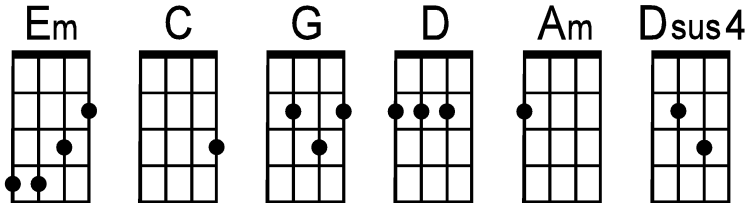


# May It Be (Key of G)

To play in original key of A, capo up two frets

(sing g)
