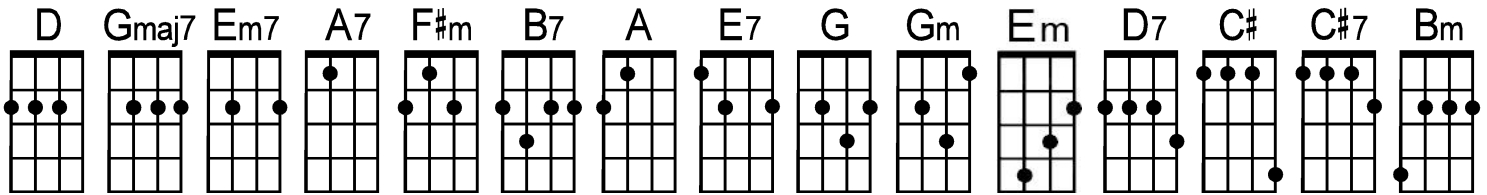


Me and My Shadow (Key of D)
