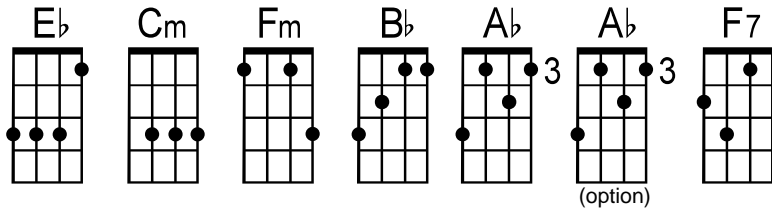


Return to Sender (original key)
