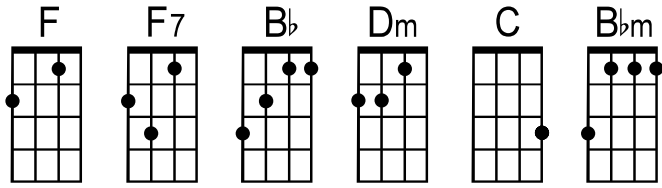


That Flamin' Ukulele in the Sky (key of F)
