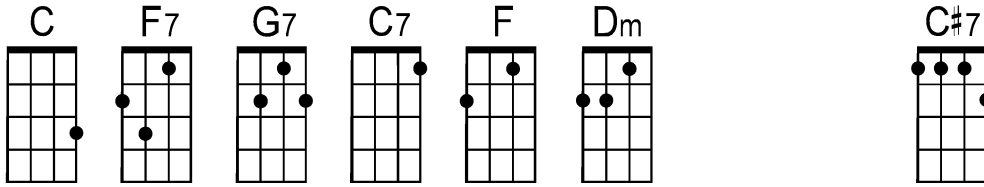


Walking After Midnight
