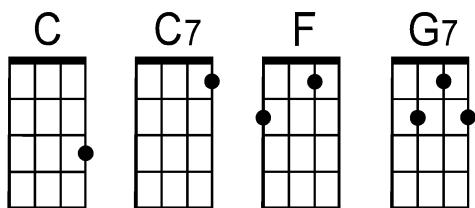


# We'll Sing in the Sunshine (key of C)
