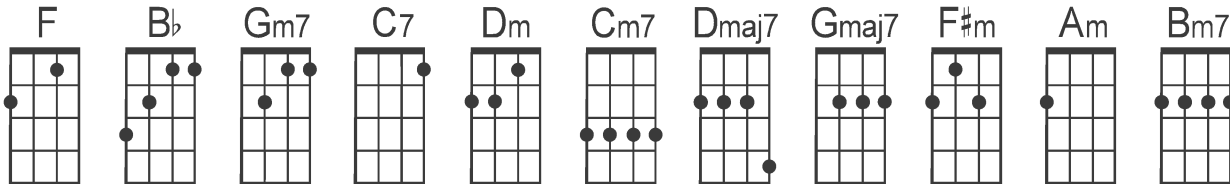


Wouldn't It Be Nice
