

Any Time (EZ version, with a few **chromatic** "walking" chords added)

Original key is G; this version in the key of F

(chord name + / = two beats; see chords at end of fourth line)

(If D7 on line 1 is 2223, then **Db7** is 1112; same chord shape, one fret away)

(If Bb on line 3 is 3211, then **A** is 2100; same chord shape, one fret away)

(If Bb on line 3 is 3211, barring first fret with your index finger, then **Bbm** is 3111, releasing your middle finger)

Suggested intro: F / D7 / G7 / C7 / F / Bb / F /
