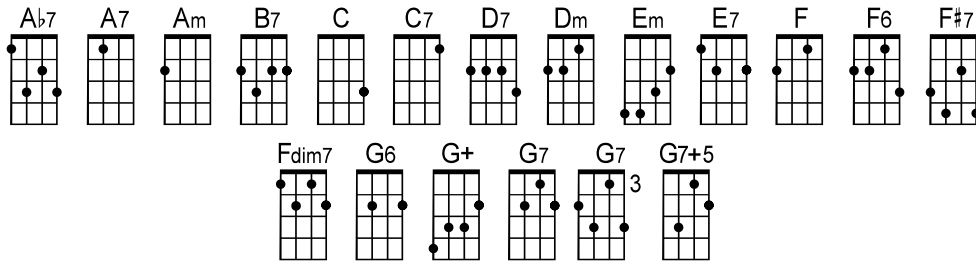


Hard Hearted Hannah
