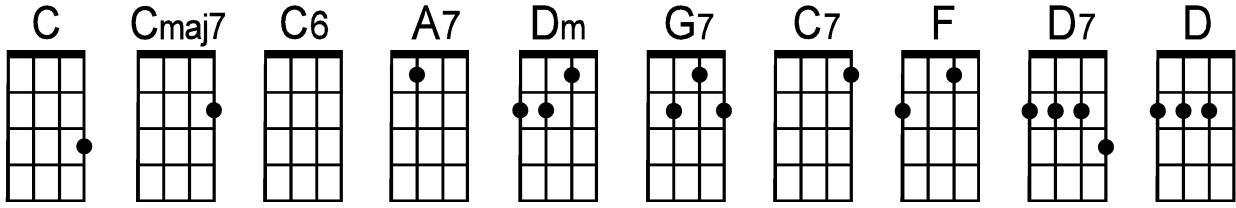


Are You Lonesome Tonight? (key of C)
