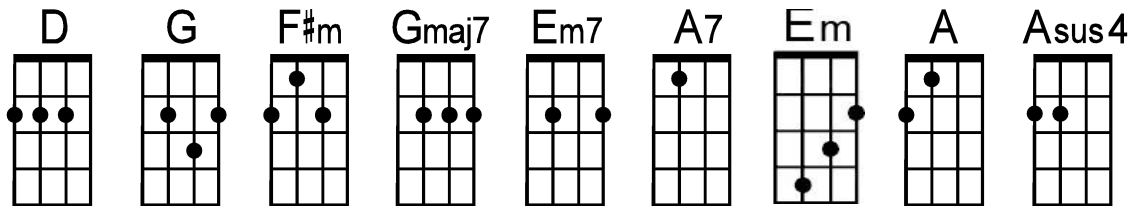


Ballad of Easy Rider
