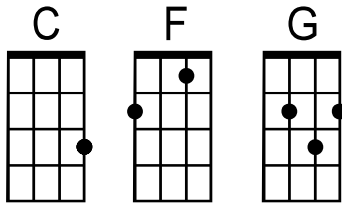


Down on the Corner
