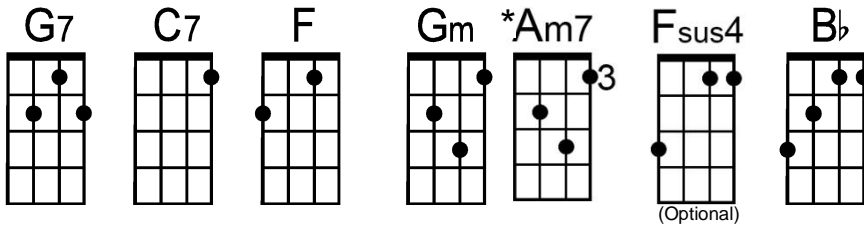


Haole Hula
