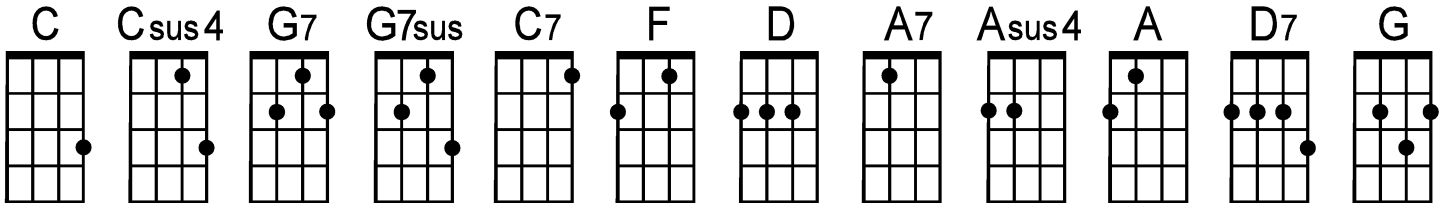


Here Comes That Rainbow Again
