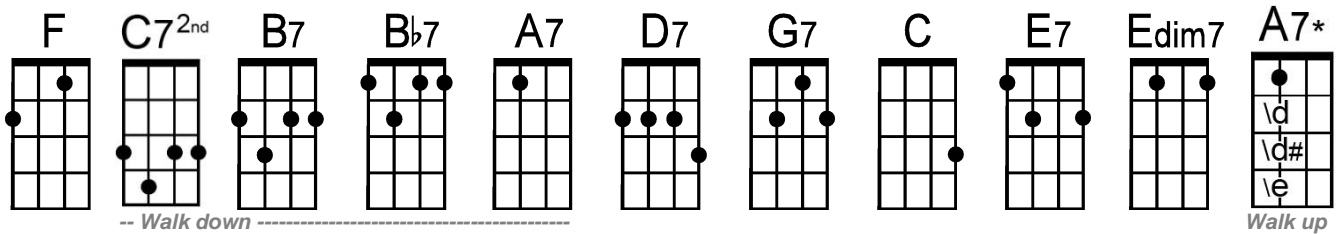


I Don't Know Enough About You
