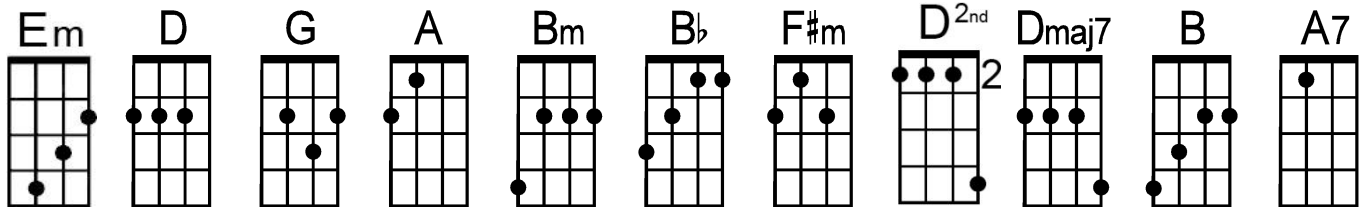


I Left My Heart In San Francisco (key of D)
