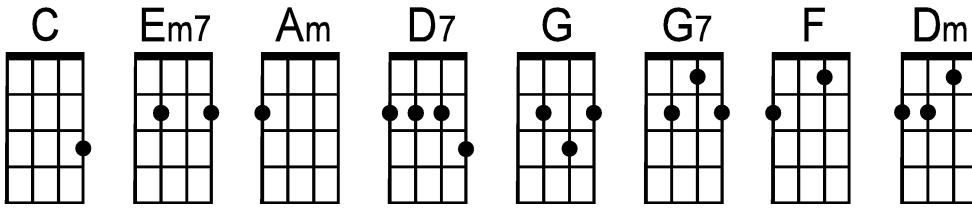


# Star Spangled Banner
